Each year an estimated 20,000 youth in transition exit the foster care system. National statistics report that 25% are immediately homeless, 70% enter the criminal justice system within 5 years, less than 3% obtain any type of degree, 70% remain unemployed. The youth we serve have no money, no employment options, no driver's license, no education, and very little hope.
